## INTRODUCCIÓN Y MUESTRA DE ITINERARIO DÍA POR DÍA

### Día 1: Sabado, 15 | Salida de la Tierra Santa

Hacer su camino a su aeropuerto local, donde tomara su vuelo durante la noche. Las comidas se sirven a bordo.

### Día 2: Domingo, 16 | Llegada a Tel Aviv

A su llegada a Tel Aviv, recogerá su equipaje, y continuara hacia el area de llegada, donde serán recibidos por un guía turístico y/o conductor. Su grupo se trasladará a su hotel en Tel Aviv. Disfrutar de la cena en el hotel antes de retirarse por la noche.

### Día 3: Lunes, 17 | Cesárea - Stella Maris - Nazareth - Tiberiades

#### Tema: La Anunciación

Después del desayuno en su hotel, su grupo se dirigirá a Cesarea, la antigua capital de Judea. Tendrá la oportunidad de visitar los restos arqueológicos de este antiguo puerto, que ayudaron como base para la marina de Herodes. Poco después de la época de Jesucristo, se reveló a Pedro, en Cesarea, que la Buena Nueva (arrepentirse) no sólo está destinado a personas judías, sino también, al mundo entero. Este es también el lugar que terminó oficialmente la tradición de adherirse a las leyes ceremoniales judías. Como resultado, Pedro bautizó a un grupo de gentiles, el centurión romano, Cornelio y su familia. Su recorrido continúa a medida que viajan del Norte a Haifa. En Haifa, se encuentra Stella Maris, un monasterio carmelita. El monasterio está situado por encima de la cueva donde Elías, el profeta, una vez vivió. Una pintura colorida de este "milagrero" se puede encontrar en el techo de la Iglesia. Después de esta visita, el grupo partirá a Stella Maris y disfrutar del paseo panorámico (con vista de la bahía de Acco) a Nazaret. En Nazaret, experimentará la ciudad donde María vivió y donde Jesús vivió de niño (Mateo 2:23). Durante la visita a Nazaret, el grupo visitará la iglesia bizantina de San José, para que la tradición identifica como el taller y el hogar de la familia santa. Además, el grupo visitará Pozo de María, donde el ángel Gabriel anunció a la Virgen María que dará a luz al Hijo de Dios (Lucas 1: 30-34). Su primer día culmina con una transferencia a Tiberiades. A su llegada a Tiberiades, se le check-in en el hotel para la cena y alojamiento.

### Día 4: Martes, 18 | Tiberiades: Mar de Galilea

#### Tema: El Ministerio de Cristo en Galilea

Su grupo se iniciará este día con el desayuno en el hotel, seguido de un paseo en barco por el hermoso y pintoresco, Mar de Galilea (Lucas 5: 1). Durante este viaje, el grupo también ver los restos de un barco que se remonta a la época de Jesús. Tras el mar de Galilea, su grupo va a continuar en el Monte de las Bienaventuranzas, donde Jesús proclamó su gran sermón de la montaña (Lucas 6: 20-49). Cerca del montaje es Tabgha, uno de los sitios milagro de Jesús. En Tabgha, Jesús alimentó a la multitud de 5.000 personas de cinco panes y dos peces (Lucas 9: 10-17). Además, en Tabgha es Primacia de San Pedro, donde Jesús otorgó liderazgo de la iglesia sobre Pedro (Juan 21: 9). Su recorrido continúa al visitar el lugar de nacimiento de María Magdalena, en Magdalena. Durante el tiempo de Jesús, este pueblo era un pueblo de pescadores próspera que exporta pescado y garum (una reducción de salsa de pescado; popular en la cocina romana). Su día concluye en Capernaum, el lugar de lanzamiento del ministerio de Jesús. En Cafarnaüm, su grupo tendrá la oportunidad de ver la Sinagoga de donde Jesús enseñó (Marcos 1: 21-29), y dio su sermón sobre el pan de vida. Su grupo disfrutará de la cena y alojamiento en el hotel.

### Día 5: Miercoles, 19 | Mt. Tabor - Jericho - Río Jordán - Jerusalén

#### Tema: La transfiguración

Después del desayuno, su grupo conducirá al sitio de la Transfiguración, el Monte Tabor (Mateo 17: 1-50). En este sitio, usted tendrá un tiempo para reflexionar sobre la Humanidad y Divinidad de Cristo. Su grupo también tendrá la oportunidad de celebrar la misa en la Basílica de la Transfiguración. El recorrido continúa a medida que su grupo se dirige al sur en el valle del Jordán, a la ciudad habitada más antigua del mundo, Jericó (Josué 6: 12-25). En Jericó, usted tendrá la oportunidad de ver la ubicación exacta, el Monte de la Tentación, de donde el diablo tentó a Jesús durante su ayuno de cuarenta días (Lucas 4: 1). Después de la visita a esta montaña, el grupo seguirá sitio de bautismo de Jesús en el río Jordán (Mateo 3: 13-17). Después de algún tiempo en el río Jordán, su grupo va a terminar el día con una transferencia a Jerusalén. En Jerusalén, su grupo check-in en el hotel para la cena y alojamiento.

### Día 6: Jueves, 20 | Jerusalén: Templo Modelo - Ein Karem - Belén

#### Tema: La Visitación y el Nacimiento

Esta mañana, usted tendrá el desayuno y luego salir por un día en Jerusalén, donde se encuentra el templo al que se presentó Jesús (Lucas 2:22). Su grupo visitará un modelo del segundo templo, como lo fue en la época de Jesús. Después de esta visita, el grupo tomará un corto trayecto en coche hasta el pueblo de Ein Karem, el lugar de nacimiento de Juan el Bautista. Se sabe que hay dos iglesias en Ein Karem, ambos en representación de las dos casas de Zacarías e Isabel. El primero se encuentra en un valle donde el nacimiento de San Juan Bautista se conmemora (Lucas 1: 39-80) en la Iglesia de la Natividad de San Juan Bautista. El segundo es sobre una colina donde Elizabeth pasó cinco meses en reclusión (Lucas 1,24) en la iglesia de la Visitación. Su grupo visitará ambas iglesias y tener la oportunidad de rezar el misterio del rosario

mientras camina por la colina hasta la Iglesia de la Visitación. Por la tarde, el grupo se trasladará a Belén, el lugar de nacimiento de Jesús. En Belén, usted tendrá la oportunidad de ver los campos del Pastor (Lucas 2: 8). En las cuevas de estos campos, que todavía son capaces de ver las marcas de hollín de los incendios que los pastores iluminados para mantener el calor. El recorrido concluye en la Plaza del Pesebre, que se encuentra en frente de la Iglesia de la Natividad. Al entrar en la Iglesia, se procederá a la Gruta de la Natividad, que marca el lugar del nacimiento de Nuestro Salvador (Mateo 2: 1-18). Debajo del altar, hay una estrella de plata y una inscripción en latín que dice: HIC DE MARIA VIRGINE Jesus Christus NATUS (Aquí Jesucristo nació de la Virgen María). Después de la misa en este espacio sagrado, el grupo volverá al hotel para cena y alojamiento.

### Día 7: Viernes, 21 | Betania - Mar Muerto

#### Tema: Los primeros años en Jerusalén y el desierto

Después del desayuno en su hotel, el grupo viajará por el Valle del Jordán a Qumrán. Qumrán se compone de 2.000 años de antigüedad ruinas de la época del Segundo Templo, y también el sitio donde los Rollos del Mar Muerto fueron escritos y descubrió (Ezequiel 47: 8-10). Estos escritos han ayudado aún más la comprensión de origen judío en el cristianismo. El tiempo y el clima lo permite, su grupo tendrán la oportunidad de tomar un flotador en el Mar Muerto, el punto más bajo y el más salado de la Tierra. Su gira continuará a medida que viajan a través del desierto de Judea, el sitio donde Jesús pasó sus 40 días de ayuno. El día de turismo culmina con una transferencia a Betania. Betania es el sitio donde Jesús levantó a Lázaro de entre los muertos, que prefigura su propia resurrección (Juan 11: 38-44). Su grupo celebrará la misa y volver al hotel para cena y alojamiento.

### Día 8: Sabado, 22 | Jerusalén: Mt. De los Olivos - Getsemaní - Mt. Zion - Muro Occidental

#### Tema: Domingo de Ramos y la agonía en el jardín

Después del desayuno, vamos a hacer nuestro camino hacia el Monte de los Olivos, donde se podrá disfrutar de la vista panorámica de Jerusalén. Históricamente, el Monte de los Olivos fue un lugar de paso obligatorio para Jesús durante muchos momentos más representativos. Su grupo visitará el santuario de Padre Nuestro, donde Jesús enseñó a sus discípulos la oración del Señor (Padre Nuestro) (Lucas 11: 1-4). Tendrá la oportunidad de parar en Dominus Flevit, que es una Iglesia que conmemora donde Jesús lloró por Jerusalén (Lucas 19:41). El recorrido continúa hacia Getsemaní, un jardín a los pies del Monte de los Olivos. Jesús trajo a sus discípulos a rezar aquí la noche antes de ser crucificado (Lucas 22: 29-53). El jardín aún contiene árboles con raíces que se remontan a la época de Jesús. Junto al Jardín es su próxima parada, la Iglesia de Todas las Naciones, construido sobre la "Roca de la Agonía". Aquí es donde Jesús oró solo en la noche de su arresto. A lo largo de este tiempo, se le invita a permanecer en oración y reflexionar sobre la agonía de Cristo que experimentó. Su grupo tendrá la oportunidad de visitar el Muro Occidental, que es el último vestigio del templo judío después de que fue destruido en el año 70 El recorrido continúa a medida que se visita la casa del Sumo Sacerdote Caifás (Iglesia de San Pedro en Gallicantu). Esta Iglesia conmemora donde Jesús fue examinada y finalmente encarcelado antes de que el Consejo en Jerusalén. También conmemora la negación de Pedro de Cristo (Juan 18: 15-18), "el arrepentimiento, y Jesús 'Peters perdón de Pedro. También visitará el Cenáculo en el Monte Sión. El Cenáculo es el lugar donde Jesús y sus discípulos celebraron la Última Cena (Mateo 26: 17-30) y, cuando Jesús se apareció a sus discípulos después de su muerte y resurrección (Marcos 16:14). Además, el grupo visitará la cercana iglesia benedictina de la Dormición. La tradición nos dice que esta Iglesia es donde María, la Madre de Jesús, "se durmió." Al final de este día de oración, su grupo volverá a su hotel para cena y alojamiento.

### Día 9: Domingo, 23 | Jerusalén: Vía Dolorosa - Santo Sepulcro

#### Tema: El Camino de la Cruz, la crucifixión, la resurrección

Su grupo tendrá una mañana muy temprano para despertar, que comenzará la Vía Dolorosa (El Camino de la Cruz) en la Fortaleza Antonia. Este es el lugar donde Jesús fue condenado a muerte por Poncio Pilato (Juan 18: 28-19: 16). Tras su condena, fue alzado (en el camino al Calvario) hasta el lugar de la crucifixión. Su grupo reflexionar sobre las Estaciones de la Cruz a medida que viajan a través de los mercados de la Ciudad Vieja a la Iglesia del Santo Sepulcro (Lucas 23: 26-33). Este destino es el sitio sagrado del Calvario (de Jesús a cabo la crucifixión) y, Su tumba (Lucas 23: 50-55). Su grupo va a celebrar la misa en la Iglesia del Santo Sepulcro. Después de la misa, el grupo volverá al hotel para disfrutar del desayuno. Vamos a seguir el día con una visita a la Iglesia de Santa Ana, la casa de los abuelos maternos de Jesús (Ana y Joaquín); y la piscina de Betesda, donde Jesús curó al paralítico (Juan 5: 1-9). Esta tarde, el grupo disfrutará de una nueva visita a la ciudad vieja. Después de esta visita, el grupo disfrutará de la cena y alojamiento en el hotel.

### Día 10: Lunes, 24 | Regreso a casa

Después de un desayuno temprano y despedidas de corazón, el grupo saldrá en autocar y traslado al aeropuerto de Tel Aviv vuelos de regreso.

Claims MUST be filed NO LATER than six (6) months after initial cancellation. After six months, no reimbursement can be provided. Insurance is Non refundable and Non Transferable.

**AIR TRANSPORTATION** Air transportation is in economy class on IATA-approved carriers. Ticketing must be completed no later than 14 days prior to departure. Fares are based on levels in effect at the time of printing and prices and schedules are subject to change without notice. All is subject to the airlines terms of carriage. 206 Tours is not responsible for any cancellations, loss, delays, injury, illness, or expenses incurred due to actions made by the airlines. Business class is available at additional cost for the Trans-Atlantic portions of your ticket. For any issues which arise in relation to airline service complaints and compensation should be addressed to the specific carrier.

**AIRPORT TAXES, FEES & FUEL CHARGES** Airport taxes are included in our four packages. Airport taxes are based on departure city and government fees (airport taxes include Federal Inspection Fees for the U.S. Customs and Immigration; International Air Transportation Tax; Agricultural tax; security fees, and other airport related taxes).

**SEAT ASSIGNMENT** Random seats are assigned for all group participants. If you would like to secure a specific seat, or sit with a companion please advise us of such request at the time of booking, we will make an effort to accommodate you, however we cannot guarantee. If you must have specific seat we recommend you to be at the airport at least three hours prior to departure and arrange the seat assignment with your airline's gate agent. Bulkhead and exit row seating can never be requested prior to the day of departure. 206 Tours can never guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline & are pending availability, subject to aircraft/seat map changes.

**LAND ONLY** Transfers are NOT included in Land Only costs. From time to time, a tour may be canceled due to non-materialization. If you chose to purchase a Land Only package and arrange your own domestic or international flight independently of us, be advised that 206 Tours is not responsible for domestic or international flights or transfers of any kind. Booked or purchased items outside of 206tours are sole responsibility of client.

**TRANSFERS** Our programs include group round-trip transfers. Pilgrims or passengers who did not purchase "all-inclusive tour" or who purchased land only package and are arriving or leaving independently must transfer at their own expense. Expenses incurred for transfers due to lateness of flights are at the expense of the passenger and may be claimed for reimbursement from the airlines. No smoking is allowed on motor coach.

### HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Hotel accommodations are based on twin-bedded or double rooms. 206 Tours reserves the right to substitute similar category hotels without prior notice.

### PRIVATE ROOMS and SINGLE SUPPLEMENT

A limited number of single rooms is available (on request basis only) at the supplement price. Single rooms provide privacy, but they are in some hotels smaller than twin or double rooms and sometimes may be poorly located, especially in the older hotels. As a general ratio we are able to confirm 10% of the total number of group participants in single rooms. If ratio is higher special supplements may be implemented for something referred to "single in double room" at an additional rate to the single supplement rate listed. If passengers are traveling alone and wish to have 206 Tours assign a roommate we will do our best, however, if we do not succeed in assigning a same sex roommate for you, you will be responsible for the additional Single Supplement fees.

**TRIPLE ROOMS** In most hotels (other than Paris) triple accommodation is possible, however, no reduction in cost is available. Due to pace of our pilgrimage schedule it's a challenge to open up all 3 suitcases and everyone's hand luggage; take showers and be on the move within appropriate time. First Class and Superior Tourist Class Hotels in general are not set up for triple rooms. Hotels usually either add a third bed which is like a fold up bed or a sofa bed. At times such as in Paris it is either impossible or worse it's the "Murphy bed". For that reason we discourage booking triple rooms. **MEALS** Most trips includes two meals per day (breakfast and dinners) which are served at your hotel or local restaurants. Beverages are not included with dinners where not indicated. In case you chose not to have a meal, there is no refund for unused meals. Although we cannot guarantee, we will try and accommodate each special meal request on flights as well as at hotels. Please advise of such a request at the time of booking. We can not guarantee that special meal/diet requests can be met.

**BAGGAGE** Each tour participant is permitted to bring one checked suitcase, one small carry on bag (8" x 14" x 22"), and one personal item (i.e. purse, laptop case). In general, the airlines permit 1 checked bag weighing up to 50 lbs (23 kg) and maximum dimensions of 62 in (158 cm) calculated by adding the length + the width + the height of the bag. Please check with your specific airline to verify the size and weight allowances. 206 Tours is not responsible for the loss of, theft of, delay, or damage to a participant's belongings.
